Training Academy of South Africa

Occupational Health Services

Medicare24 conducts Pre-employment, Annual, and Exit medical examinations. All relevant, non-confidential information is reported and submitted to the Human Resources Department. These reports state if an employee is fit to work. Occupational Health also provides Medical Surveillance, Health and Safety Management, Absenteeism, Health Awareness Campaigns, Member Education, and Counselling Services.

Clinical Services

This service offers on-site assistance with disease prevention, illness diagnosis, illness treatments, and primary health diseases. Individuals receive medication at no additional cost. The staff enjoys the benefit of visiting the clinic as often as necessary. One of the main benefits to the employer, based on decreased absenteeism rates and higher productivity levels, is the return on their investment.

Paramedical Services

Our expertise in this field has provided onsite Paramedical Services to our clients for over a decade. The service meets specific client needs by the number of medics required on site and the function required. Our responsible medical personnel is trained stabilization and treatment of all medical and trauma emergencies that may occur on-site. We have partnered with ER24 Medical Emergency Services, which benefits members who use our on-site clinics. They can enroll themselves and up to six family members in the system, enabling them access to the ER24 ambulance fleet at no extra cost. We have long standing relationships with Mibem and Netcare 911 in South Africa, who together form a reputable network of ambulance service providers.

HIV Management

To establish high levels of service at all times, this Wellness Programme takes a multi-disciplinary approach over an agreed period. The Medicare24 HIV Management Programme comprises of four Phases: Education and Awareness, an HIV Committee, free Voluntary Counselling and Testing (VCT), and a Positive Living Programme.

Lifeguard Services

Our lifeguards are vital assets in any water situation. Our team consists of highly skilled individuals with qualifications in Pool Rescue and Open Water/Surf Rescue. This multi-faceted team ensures that in peak times, their emergency response is fast, efficient, and relevant to the type of water incident.

Our lifeguards hold accreditations with the South African Lifeguards Association of South Africa. Skills remain up-to-date and current, resulting in increased qualifications and certification for the teams.

We have 56 lifeguards employed within our company and take pride in the fact that we service one of the largest water parks in South Africa, which has multiple swimming pools, water slides, and a wave pool.

Having them on-site as part of the medical team ensures that the transfer of a patient to the Paramedic and Emergency Teams is handled professionally at all times during an emergency.

Primary Health Care Clinics

Primary Health Care uses medical care as the first line of treatment and focuses on health screening and the early diagnosis and treatment of any illness. It is the first phase of medical care, before hospitalisation and specialist care. This phase of health care covers 85% of the most common illnesses and diseases. Medicare24 establishes, implements, and maintains on-site Primary Health Care Clinics which offer sustainable and easily accessible preventative care services.

All on-site Medicare24 clinics meet the specific needs and requirements of the client.

Wellness 4 Life

This programme provides Voluntary Counselling and testing (VCT) for HIV, with additional Occupational Health Services. Voluntary Counselling and Testing for HIV encompasses testing people for HIV to establish the infection rate within South Africa for businesses projecting production levels and income for the future.

Occupational Health screens the employee based on standards and specifications outlined in the Occupational Health Services Act of South Africa.

The primary purpose of Occupational Health is to identify underlying health problems and those acquired during an employee performing their duties. This service includes employee medicals and Occupational Health Training.

The Opportunity

The Bill of Rights, Section 27 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa (1996), states that access to health care is a fundamental human right. South Africa is facing an ongoing crisis in the public health care system is seriously inadequate. This poor system has roots dating back to the Colonial period when its citizens determined the type of health care they received. This system still demonstrates the inequitable distribution of healthcare resources and inadequate healthcare quality. The primary purpose of Public Health Clinic Services is to promote health, prevent illness, cure disease, and, where necessary, refer patients to the hospital. Provincial Clinics, Community Health Centres, and District Hospitals offer these services. Government expenditure on health programs appears stable and averages around 13.5% of total Government spend. Allocations to provincial health programs show no sign of positive growth, which is concerning. In the face of ongoing budget constraints, governments are struggling with appalling rising healthcare costs and the increased demand for healthcare services. As governments grapple to stretch their healthcare funds and produce better results, many rely on Public/Private Partnerships (PPPs) within the private sector.

Mobile Clinics

Medicare24 has established mobile clinic facilities. These specially assembled on-the-move units are for communities living in rural areas who do not have access to transport to a government clinic. Our Mobile Service units bring quality healthcare to their doorsteps via a bus converted into a state-of-the-art healthcare facility. Mobile trailer units are placed at various rural sites and transported from site to site on completion of patient care. The units are valuable for corporate companies that require Occupational Health Care facilities.

Large organisations with multiple staff usually require that an on-site clinic be available to their employees. Medicare 24 will produce a complete clinic solution depending on the client's requirements. Our clinics are fully equipped with medical staff that deal with day-to-day patient care with Primary Health Care, Occupational Health Care, and Emergency Medical Services. If required, Medicare24 can provide a permanent ambulance on-site capable of handling any medical emergencies on the property and surrounding areas. Medicare 24 has an internal design team that will convert any space allocated by the client into a state-of-the-art healthcare centre for their employees.

Our professional team complies with a legal framework. Shipping containers can be modified and converted into Primary Health Care units. These units are beneficial in rural areas where access to clinics is challenging. The container clinics are insulated with indoor plumbing and become permanent clinic facilities. We can convert 6m and 12m containers to the client's requirements. Our core value is to increase the health and vitality of every individual who requires care.



VACCINATION SITES



Sun City

Sun City and Medicare24 opened its largest corporate vaccination clinic in the country for Sun International which employs 8500 people. The site was fully functional and compliant within two days. The vaccination site provided inoculations for Sun City and the surrounding areas.

Ekurhuleni

A large-scale vaccination site was assembled in Ekurhuleni within seven days. The 2000m square foot tent is one of the largest yet. Extensive marketing and communication created a unique facility with a positive outcome.



Global Aid

Medicare24 has a long-standing service history to the community, often going above and beyond the call of duty in South Africa and across our borders. We take great pride in our past and current achievements. Medicare24's internal staff are passionate about helping others and assisting on a pro-bono basis.

Sports Heroes Walk Against AIDS

Sports Heroes Walk Against AIDS Sports Heroes Walk against Aids is an initiative by SABC sports presenter Cynthia Tshaka to raise awareness through sports among the youth about HIV infection, making responsible decisions, and living a healthy lifestyle. Sporting heroes Baby Jake Matlala, Willie Mtolo, Khaya Malotana, Desiree Ellis, Artulu Ballosini, Daleen Terblanche, Deshun Deysel, and Lihlohonolo Ledwaba participated in the 5th annual Sports Heroes Walk Against Aids campaign in 2006. The six-day walk is from Pretoria to Mafikeng in the Northwest Province. Sports celebrities felt that there was a need to do something to stop the suffering of children infected and affected by HIV/Aids. As a result, they began to walk from one province to the other to make the whole country aware of the plight of the children and to urge fellow South Africans to share in the responsibility of caring for our children. Medicare 24 has been the emergency medical provider for this annual project since its inception in 2002.

Asenzi Youth Development

Asenzi Youth Development was established in February 2009 after it became apparent that the youth of Vosloorus lacked life skills. Asenzi's vision was to nurture dreams to give hope and purpose to the youth and cultivate community involvement. In July 2009, Medicare24 hosted a fun day for 35 orphans and children with disabilities at Mohau's orphanage in Mapleton, Ekurhuleni. At the end of a fulfilling day, they were gifted with donations by Simelani Traders and Medicare24. Mohau's home is one of the longest-serving homes in Vosloorus.

Tsunami Disaster (2004/2005)

Medicare24 gathered financial assistance from South African businesses and created a specialised medical team that flew to Indonesia within days of the Tsunami disaster on 26 December 2004. With the blessing of the Indonesian government, the medical team headed to Malebo, a town destroyed by the Tsunami. The team set up emergency clinics and treated over 150 refugees daily, together with the United Nations, Red Cross, Indonesian and Singapore military, and Canadian relief teams. Ten grueling days later, the rebel unrest grew to terrifying proportions. Many relief teams, including Medicare24, were relieved of their duties due to safety concerns. Medicare24 received a certificate of thanks from the Indonesian Government for their relief efforts.

OUR PROJECTS



RTT UNJANI CLINIC-IN-A-BOX

IIn February 2011, we joined hands with the RTT Group to assist the Unjani Clinic-in-a-Box initiative. This initiative provided much-needed clinical services to the disadvantaged in the Etwata and Wattville informal settlements. Members of the community aided the clinic's operation. We were able to reduce the management fees by more than 20%

Camp quality

Every year, children fighting life-threatening cancer are hosted by different organizations and spend a weekend at camp. Medicare24 is a proud sponsor of this event, supplying paramedic pro-bono services.

Buddy

Buddy is a therapy dog who works with one of our Medicare24 counselors. Buddy provides healing to victims of abuse or who have suffered trauma. Medicare24 sponsors Buddy's food and medical bills.

ARV/HIV Assisstance

The Wikoppen Health and Wellness Centre and St Francis Clinic assists individuals in the surrounding townships such as Diepsloot, Lion Park, and Kya Sands. Unfortunately, the HIV infection statistics in these areas are excessive. Medicare 24 and Tsogo Sun Holdings proudly donated over R800 000 in Antiretroviral Drugs.

Medicare24 also supported their local Clinic (St Francis) by donating R400 000.

USAID


In November 2008, we proudly tested 30 000 males in South Africa for HIV and increased awareness around the virus through various talks and information sessions.

Disaster Recovery

Haiti Earthquake

A team was sent to Haiti on 24 January 2010, armed with medical bags and facing the daunting task of treating the survivors of the horrific quake. The team landed in Haiti within 38 hours after departing from South Africa. Their duty was to provide vital medical treatment. They treated approximately 400 people in one week. The team returned to South Africa on 1 February 2010.







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
